






**YOUTH CHALLENGE PROVINCIAL FINALS
GRANDVIEW LANES, VANCOUVER & NECHAKO BOWLING LANES, PRINCE GEORGE
NOVEMBER 9, 2019
RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Open to all bowlers who are **twelve (12) years of age** and not yet nineteen (19) years of age as of December 31, 2019.
2. The entry deadline shall be **November 2, 2019**. Late entries may be accepted provided space is available at the discretion of the Tournament Chair.
3. **Entry fee is \$55.00.** (Includes BC 5 Pin membership card fee.)
4. Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association rules and regulations shall apply in all rounds.
5. In case of any disputes, the decision of the BC 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee (for the Provincial finals) and the Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee (for the National finals) shall be final.
6. **Dress Code: All bowlers participating in the BC 5 Pin Bowlers Association Youth Challenge Provincial Championships will be required to wear: Female either black dress pants, dress shorts, skirt, skort, capris or yoga pants (no fluorescent colours, leggings, stirrups or denim of any kind). No draw strings or elastic at the hem of any kind. No studs, buttons or pockets on the legs. Male bowlers will either wear black dress pants or dress shorts that do not have studs, buttons or pockets on the legs. All participants will be required to either wear the YBC bowling shirt that represents their bowling center, Youth Challenge national team shirt or a golf shirt. While the tournament is in progress no hats or caps will be allowed unless worn for religious or medical reasons. This is to protect the integrity, atmosphere and attitude of the sport of 5 pin bowling. Failure to adhere to the dress code will result in the bowler not being allowed to participate in the tournament.**
7. The Provincial Championships shall be bowled on November 09, 2019 at Grandview Lanes, Vancouver and Nechako Bowling Lanes, Prince George starting at 1:00 pm.
8. The Provincial Championships shall consist of eight (8) games.
9. Lineage at the Provincial Championship will be paid by the BC 5 Pin Bowlers' Association.
10. It is the responsibility of each individual to get to the Provincial Championships.
11. The top three (3) men and top three (3) ladies, based on **SCRATCH** total pinfall at the Provincial Championships will make up the Provincial Team and advance to the National Championships.
12. The top male and female SCRATCH scorers, will each receive a \$250 scholarship.
13. A lane draw will be pre-drawn from the entries received for the Provincial Championship.
14. **Each bowler and coach advancing to the National finals will be assessed \$250.00 towards the cost of going to the National Championships.**

NEW** The top male and female PINS OVER AVERAGE scorers will each be awarded a \$100 scholarship. ****NEW**
